





October Featured Speaker: Richard Carrrico







Richard Carrico has worked as an archaeologist in southern California since 1974. He will be speaking about the archaeological record as it relates to selected rock art sites in our region. This will be an extremely informative opportunity for SDRAA members to hear from one of California's most experienced professionals.

Richard L. Carrico, a Ramona resident and wine maker, is a lecturer in the Department of American Indian Studies at San Diego State University and an adjunct professor in the Behavioral Sciences Department at San Diego City College and Mesa Community Colleges where he teaches anthropology. In addition to more than 30 publications in professional journals, Richard is the author of the recently released *Images of America Series: Ramona* (Arcadia Publications May 2011); Strangers in a Stolen Land: The Indians of San Diego County from Prehistory to the New Deal (Sunbelt Publications 2008) and History of the Wineries of San Diego County (Recuerdos Press 2007—soon to be reissued in an expanded format); he also has authored standalone chapters in three academic books.
