It has become an annual SDRAA tradition to provide a forum for members to present their "old" film camera transparencies as our featured program for the June general meeting — thus the name "Nostalgia Night." In light of the COVID-19 induced precautions, the SDRAA Core Committee has elected to hold a virtual "Nostalgia Night" event hosted on the Zoom teleconferencing platform. Several like-minded organizations have found success in providing this alternative to their educational meetings. Below you'll find an outline of our simple guidelines for presenters. We encourage you to join us in this enriching program that blends modern technology with nostalgia.

In the meantime, please submit your images for the program using the steps outlined below.

Basic Premise

Each presenter should view their rock art-related program as a 10-minute, or less, slide show. The individual program slides (digital photos) will be uploaded at the link below. Members who tune in will be able to use their computer, tablet, or smart phone to display and hear the content fully. The presenters will be shown "live" on a small portion of the screen narrating their program. Therefore, these will be "live" presentations, much like programs on good old fashioned TV.

Process

1. Accepted content: Individual digital photos. We are discouraging "slick" PowerPoint presentations because we want to remain somewhat true to the "Old School" theme of Nostalgia Night. Besides, it is really easy to prepare a set of digital images (i.e., slides).

2. Preparation: You will need to correctly number individual digital photos so that we may present them in your intended order. The file naming format is as follows: two digit number followed by an underscore "_" symbol. For numbers less than 10, use a leading zero.

examples: 01_Penny Ranch Picto.jpg 14_Perris Lake Picto.jpg

3. Narration: Simply be prepared to talk about your subject. Remember, you will be on screen as well. This helps make that personal connection with the audience. To add a "nostalgic flavor" to the proceedings, be prepared to say "Next Slide" when you want our host to advance to the next image. Actually, we couldn't think of a better way and we like the corniness.

4. Uploading Files: To upload your files follow this link:
