Many researchers, including J. J. Brody, Myles Miller, and Polly Schaafsma, have compared Mimbres ceramics to Jornada Mogollon rock art. These researchers mainly used the well-known images at Three Rivers, New Mexico. While Three Rivers is an excellent place to start, most of these comparisons were done without the benefit of the Mimbres Pottery Images Digital Database (MimPIDD) and depended mostly on images from publications. Having lived in and explored southern New Mexico and west Texas for the last 14 years, I have had the great pleasure of visiting hundreds of sites that I will use for comparison with examples of Mimbres ceramics from the MimPIDD. This is part of an on going research project.
