The El Vallecito Archaeological Project La Rumorosa Style Rock Art in Context A Presentation by Antonio Porcayo-Michelini

For eight years, the archaeologist Antonio Porcayo-Michelini has directed the El Vallecito Archaeological Project focused on conducting research and an inventory of all the archaeological manifestations that the archaeological zone contains, including the sites with La Rumorosa Style rock art. The results of these years of work, in which a Yuman world much more complex than originally thought has been revealed, will be presented in the talk, and its understanding will be completed with another series of Yuman archaeological works and findings that Porcayo has made in the area between the town of La Rumorosa and the border with California.

The archaeologist Antonio Porcayo-Michelini has worked at the INAH Baja California Center since 2004 developing archaeological research and salvage projects throughout the State. He has collaborated on various binational projects with various universities in California and Oregon. Since 2018 he is a Titular member of the Northern Zone of the INAH Archaeological Council.
